CORE CURRICULUM £5,187

First study (45 minutes per week), musicianship studies, choir, orchestra, ensemble

ADDITIONAL INDIVIDUAL STUDY SUPPLEMENT £1,272

Additional individual study lesson (30 minutes per week)

INDIVIDUAL STUDY EXTENSION £636

Extra 15 minutes per week individual tuition

(where agreed by teacher and parent, and at the discretion of the Head of Junior Programmes)

MINI-BASS COURSE £2,043

Individual mini-bass lesson (30 minutes per week), hire of instrument, mini-bass group (45-60 minutes per week), choir, orchestra when applicable

INSTRUMENT HIRE £75 (instrument) / £40 (bow) per term

Only applicable if an instrument and/or bow are loaned from the JD instrument collection
